





The Centro de Estudios Europa Hispánica (CEEH) and Universität Hamburg invite applications for a

Doctorate Scholarship (Carl Justi-Stipendium zur Kunstgeschichte Spaniens/ Carl Justi Scholarship for the Study of the History of Spanish Art)

The scholarship starts on 1st of October 2020 and will be undertaken at the Department of Art History (Kunstgeschichtliches Seminar) of the Universität Hamburg. The scholarship is endowed with € 20.000,- annually for a duration of 36 months. The doctoral thesis can be written in German or in English.

Topics:

The doctoral project should be located in the area of Spanish art including its reception by German artists, art historians, collectors, and critics. Proposals relating to the period between the Middle Ages and the first two decades of the 20th century are particularly welcome.

Requirements:

The prerequisite for application is a completed university degree in art history. In addition, the admission requirements for a doctorate according to the doctoral regulations of the Faculty of Humanities of the Universität Hamburg must be fulfilled:

Applications with cover letter, curriculum vitae, copies of diplomas, a description of the dissertation project (max. 10 pages including a project description, leading questions, state of research, status of preliminary work if applicable, including also an abstract of the project and a timetable), two representative chapters of the master thesis as reading samples should be sent electronically in a single PDF file by 30th of June to Prof. Dr. Margit Kern: margit.kern@uni-hamburg.de. Additionally we are asking for 1 letter of recommendation from a university teacher. Please send all applications documents also to the following address: kunstgeschichte@uni-hamburg.de.

Please do not submit original documents as we are not able to return them. Any documents submitted will be destroyed after the application process has concluded.
